I also understand that a tuition fee of \$1100 will be charged to accepted applicants. My signature warrants that all information contained in this application is true and correct. I will devote the time and tuition resources required to fully participate in the Ottumwa Leadership Academy.

In the event that applicant commits a criminal act, or is charged with a criminal act; is guilty of gross negligence or is incompetent in the performance of their job related duties; is discharged from their employment; or engages in conduct which, in the sole opinion of the Ottumwa Leadership Academy brings or exposes the applicant to public disrepute, contempt or ridicule, or otherwise reflects unfavorably on the Leadership Academy, the applicant will be terminated from the program upon the majority vote of the Advisory Board, without a refund of the application fee.

The Andy Hansen Legacy Scholarship



Andy Hansen was Plant Manager at John Deere Ottumwa Works from 2010-2013. While in Ottumwa, Andy provided leadership and encouraged others to step into leadership roles. He demonstrated his leadership through volunteerism and being a board member to several community organizations including the Legacy Foundation. The Legacy Foundation wanted to honor Andy's dedication to the betterment of the Ottumwa community by creating the Andy Hansen Legacy Scholarship. The Dr. Marlene Sprouse Legacy Scholarship
